MH The WU founded Austria's first Alumni Club back in 1995 after recognizing early on the vital role of alumni. We are now in the year 2019 and, more than ever, the WU understands the importance of nurturing its

You have dropped the membership fee for the new Alumni Community...

HE ...flexible donations "from zero to infinity" suit the new WU Alumni self-image better than a fixed fee.

The WU is the first Austrian university to switch to a funding model familiar from Anglo-American institutions. Is Austria ready for it?

HE Well, Austria may not be ready, but our WU alumni certainly are! Welcoming new ideas and ways of thinking, a cosmopolitan spirit, seizing opportunities - these are the traits which WU graduates have made their own. I am extremely confident that our notion of a global, innovative and dynamic network will appeal to our alumni.

What does WU actually need its graduates' money for? The last budget negotiations were highly successful...

HE ...after the previous programme of cuts...and before the next? Donations from alumni and cooperation partners can offer a publicly-funded university a degree of political independence. And it is certainly in the alumni's interest if their university

develops its level of excellence and international profile, and can generate new knowledge. But by "support"

> we don't just mean the financial kind...

What sort of commitment is needed?

MH Every kind! Get involved, bring us your ideas, challenge us. Our WU Alumni programme grows through commitment, not by people sitting back and basking in the sun. WU graduates have so

much to offer. And they do. Whenever we need role models for the WU, we encounter openness and support. We want to strengthen this underlying sense of solidarity and affection for "my WU", in whichever form it takes, and depending on the opportunities offered by each stage of life.

When will you consider the relaunch of WU Alumni to be successful?

HE (laughing) When we are snowed under with fan post. When it becomes impossible to choose the WU Alumni Recognition Awards due to the vast number of candidates. When every alumnus supports the WU with €10 or more, which means that we can grow in excellence and move up the academic ranking! More seriously: When all alumni can say "I'm proud of the WU and its great work; I'm part of a powerful network; I want to get involved!".






And just like Billy Joel's song "Vienna", I know Vienna is always waiting for me! I wish our WU a fantastic future!
